The CANADIAN JAZZ COLLECTIVE is one of the hottest new bands on the circuit. Co-led by saxophonist Kirk MacDonald, guitarist Lorne Lofsky, and the Izzy Asper Jazz Performance's Artistic Advisor Derrick Gardner, this newly-formed septet headed to Europe in spring of 2022, and played to packed houses, including London's famed Ronnie Scott's. While in Germany, they recorded their first studio album, Septology.

JazzWise critic Kevin Whitlock emphasizes the level of talent in the CJC, but observes that it's "a refreshingly ego-free enterprise; while Lorne, Kirk and Derrick are lead composers and nominal 'leaders' there's a gloriously democratic feel about the whole enterprise: seven musicians united by a common purpose - to make great original music and mutual admiration."

to apply her considerable vocal range to a broad palette of musical styles, bringing together her classical training with gospel and jazz. She has recorded several critically acclaimed CDs and performed with such luminaries as Ramsey Lewis, Dee Dee Bridgewater, and as a "Raelette" with the great Ray Charles.

McCann is a powerful, sultry, and soulful singer with a knack for making her lyrics come to life. Arts critic Howard Reich describes her as having "a voice that soars in all registers, at all tempos, on all occasions... a voice that inspires wonder!"
